More on the NMAAHC: It's treasures include Nat Turner's Bible, Harriet Tubman's shawl, and Chuck Berry's red Cadillac convertible just a few of the 37,000 historical artifacts. Not to mention delicious food from regions across the country at the museum's original restaurant, "Sweet Home Café".

We know that many of you are concerned about getting admission to this amazing museum which is free. Currently, there is a major backlog and group reservations **CANNOT** be made at this time. We are working diligently in hopes to secure a group tour of the museum as one of the activities during the 2018 reunion.

There are other ways that you can tour the museum:

- 1. Same-day timed passes are available online, https://nmaahc.si.edu/visit/passes beginning at 6:30a.m. daily.
- 2. A limited number of walk-up passes are available starting at 1p.m. on weekdays only. The line for walk-up passes forms on the Madison Drive side of the building. Walk-up passes will be distributed one (1) per person. No walk-up passes will be available on weekends due to high visitation.
- 3. If you are an active duty military member, military retiree, or military veteran, there is no need for a timed entry pass! You and two (2) guests are allowed to enter, however, you must provide the proper identification or documentation.
